MISSIONS REPORT

First, I want to thank you all for your abundant love and prayers and support over these last several months. I'm so grateful for all of you and so excited for you to join me on this journey.

To fill you in, in August I will be participating in a mission called the World Race. My team of about 30 people from all over the U.S. and parts of Australia will be traveling to 11 countries in 11 months. We will visit parts of the world that may have never been reached with the Good News of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

The first 2 weeks of June I will be in Georgia at the headquarters of Adventures in Missions (the ministry that hosts the World Race) for my training camp. During this time we will be living in our tents and out of our packs, learning about the cultures and countries we will be traveling and ministering to, meeting our teammates, participate in a fitness test, and begin to learn how to evangelize and share the Gospel. After I return from training camp, there will be a brief period of about 6 weeks to do some last minute preparations before my team and I launch on the World Race. Our first country will be Spain.

Keep me in your prayers, please, as I travel to and from Georgia. Pray for protection and travel safety, good health, strong connections between my teammates and I, and last minute preparations for this journey.
